- <u>Video call system</u> between 3 countries.
- <u>Individual participation</u> from home.
- <u>No restriction on video call devices</u>. (PC, Tablet, Smart phone)

Activity

Corona virus is forcing us to change our lifestyle and renew our understanding of the world. In this situation, students discuss the theme "After the threat of Corona virus" with 2 questions on video call.

Through the exchange of opinions and ideas, students will develop their understanding of each other and of the world.

Aims

- 1. Develop students' understanding of the world.
- 2. Develop children's worldwide network.
- 3. Develop students' communication skills.
- 4. Provide opportunities for English communication.
- 5. Develop students' leadership skills.

Preparation

- 1. <u>Each side</u> prepares introduction of their own school.
 - Introduce your school with photos and diagrams.
 - Add presentation of <u>the current situation of the threat of Corona-virus</u>.
 - Select <u>presenter(s)</u> of your school at each side.
 - Presentation should be within <u>2 minutes.</u>
- 2. <u>Each student</u> prepares one's own answers to the <u>2 questions</u> on the worksheet according to the main theme "After the threat of Corona virus" in advance.
 - Q1: What do you think you need for yourself after the threat of Corona virus?
 - Q2: What do you think we need for our society after the threat of Corona virus?
 - Answers (opinions and ideas) should be <u>clear and concrete</u>.
 - Answers can be prepared in their own language.
 - Use short sentences so that it can be easily translated into English.

- 3. <u>Presenter(s)</u> for your school's introduction and current situation.
 - Select <u>student(s)</u> as presenter(s).
 - Only <u>one presenter</u> can present on screen. Then <u>make order</u> at your school side.
 - Presenters of each country will take turns presenting their school.
- 4. <u>Translators</u> need to understand the flow of translation, because all gather on the same screen at the same time. <u>They need to translate one by one sequentially</u>.

Conference Rules

- 1. All participating students are expected to ask questions or express opinions.
- 2. <u>Do not criticize other group's ideas or opinions</u> by own standards. Constructive questions or opinions are welcomed.
