Preparation

- 1. <u>Each side</u> prepares introduction of their own school (organization).
 - Introduce your school (organization) with photos and diagrams.
 - Add presentation of the current situation of the threat of Corona-virus.
 - Select <u>presenter(s)</u> of your school.
 - Presentation should be within 2 minutes at each side.
 - If cultural performance is added, the time will be extended.
- 2. <u>Each student</u> prepares one's own answers to the theme "What do you want to become in the future? and Why?" in advance.
 - Answers can be prepared in their own language.
 - The reason should be added. If there is a story in it, it could be added too.
 - Use <u>short sentences</u> so that it can be easily translated into English.
- 3. <u>Each student</u> prepares questions to other groups for Free Question time.
 - Any topic could be possible.
 - Questions could be for any side or all sides. (Japan, Thailand, Taiwan)
 - Write down questions in advance so that it is easy to ask questions at the meeting.
- 4. <u>Presenter(s)</u> introduce your school (organization) and current situation.
 - Select <u>student(s)</u> as presenter(s).
 - Presenters of each country will take turns presenting their school one by one.
- 5. <u>Translators</u> need to understand the flow of translation, because all gather on the same screen at the same time. <u>They need to translate one by one sequentially.</u>

Conference Rules

- 1. All participating students are expected to ask questions or express opinions.
- 2. <u>Do not criticize other group's ideas or opinions</u> by own standards. Constructive questions or opinions are welcomed.

Sequence of communication

Speaker (native language)

→ Translator (English) → [Internet]

 \rightarrow Translator 1 (native language 1) \rightarrow Students

 \rightarrow Translator 2 (native language 2) \rightarrow Students

Questioner (native language)

→ Translator (English) → [Internet]

- \rightarrow Translator 1 (native language 1) \rightarrow Speaker
- → Translator 2 (native language 2) → Speaker

Role list at the conference

- Conference manager: hosts and controls and facilitates the entire activity.
- Group managers (translators): Teachers. (Each country has one manager who takes care of their students.)
- Conference staff: support the conference and the conference manager.

• Please select students according to their ideas and will. <u>Students should not be selected according to their English ability only.</u> The aim is not English conversation but to discuss and exchange ideas beyond country borders.
