Introduction of school	15:05-15:20 (15 min.) 5 min x 3	Introduction of school. (Japan, Thailand, Malaysia) <presenters>	Introduction of school to each other. <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Each side introduces their school briefly.● Introduce with photos, videos or diagrams.● Other sides ask questions.

Preparation

1. Every student writes down one's own ideas according to the theme on the work sheet in advance.
 - Every student writes down more than one idea (image), and the reason why (evidence).
 - Imagine the changes in society around you after 20 years from now.
 - The key words for the theme are:

"Environment" "Population" "Foods" "AI" "Robots" "Gene manipulation"
 "Science and technology" "Conflict and War" "Disparity" "Peace" "Ethnicity"
 "Family" "Global warming" "Work" ...

- Consider these key words, and imagine future society around you and yourself.
 - Add enough reasons why you imagine like that as much as possible. (add evidences).
 - It doesn't matter if the image becomes optimistic or pessimistic. That image will be the base of discussion.
2. Each group (country) discuss the theme and select 2 different ideas as the group idea to present at the conference.
 - Collect each idea of all students first.
 - Discuss the theme among students, and select 2 different ideas.
 - Ideas could be mixed with different ideas, or could be developed through group discussions.
 - Reasons (evidence) of the idea should be added.
 - Prepare documents to present those 2 ideas.
 - Presentation document should be less than 5 pages for each idea.
 - Photos or drawings or diagrams will be added to the document.
 3. Each group (country) prepares documents to introduce their area and school.
 - Introduction documents will be shared in advance to save the conference time.
 - Introduce your area and school with photos and diagrams.
 - Share those documents as files in advance.
 - Presentation at the conference should be less than 5 pages.
 4. Presenters' selection.
 - Presenters of school introduction will be selected.
 - Presenters of "future image" will be selected. There are 2 images at each side.

Conference Rules

1. All participating students are expected to ask questions or express opinions.
2. Do not criticize other's ideas or opinions by your own standards. Consider the variety of histories, cultures, social systems, etc. Constructive questions or opinions are welcome.
