Preparation

- 1. <u>Each student</u> prepares one's own ideas (images) for the theme "Our expecting images of Asia in 10 years" in advance.
 - Firstly, think about the field you are interested in. Then in that field, imagine "what we would like to create in 10 years' time, as fellow Asians, interacting with each other."
 - Examples of topic: <u>"Environment issue"</u>, <u>"Waste reduction issue"</u>, <u>"World peace"</u>, <u>"Cultural exchange"</u>, <u>"People-to-people interaction"</u>, <u>"Education"</u>, <u>etc.</u>
 - Get <u>concrete images</u> as much as possible.
 - It does not matter whether the vision (image) of the future 10 years from now can actually be realized. However, we aim to present a proposal that can be realized in the future. (Indicate the stage of realization.)
 - Visions (images) could be some.
- 2. <u>Each group (country)</u> discuss the theme and <u>select 1 image (vision)</u> to present at the conference.
 - Collect ideas (images) <u>from each student</u> at the beginning.
 - Discuss the theme among students, and select 1 image (vison).
 - Make the image (vison) concrete and shape it to be realized in the future.
 - Prepare documents to present the image (vison).

- Photos or drawings or diagrams or videos will be added to the document.
- Screen sharing mode can be used.
- Presentation should be <u>less than 5 minutes long.</u>
- Phrases should be simple and short so that translation will be easier.
- Consider <u>time for translation</u>.
- 3. Each group (country) prepares documents to introduce their area and school.
 - Introduction documents will be shared in advance to save the conference time.
 - Introduce your area and school with photos and diagrams.
 - Presentation at the conference should be <u>less than 5 pages</u>.
- 4. Each group (country) prepare (bring) items which they usually use at school.
 - e.g.: textbooks, notebooks, artworks, school bags, stationeries, school uniforms, etc.
 - We show them as cultural exchange.
 - Bring those items at the conference.
- 5. Presenters' selection.
 - Presenters of <u>school introduction</u>: a few students.
 - Presenters of <u>school items</u>: a few students.
 - Presenters of the theme: a few students.

Conference Rules

- 1. All participating students are expected to <u>ask questions or express opinions</u>.
- 2. <u>Do not criticize other's ideas or opinions</u> by your own standards. Consider the variety of histories, cultures, behavior, foods, events etc. *Constructive questions or opinions are welcome.
