3. Global Communication: June 26

Preparation

- 1. Each side prepares an introduction of their school and region.
 - Introduce your school and region with photos and diagrams. (A4 or A3 panels)
 - Select <u>presenter(s)</u> from your school.
 - Presentations should be within 2 minutes on each side.
- 2. <u>Each participant</u> prepares one's own answers to the theme "What is your ideas to make world peace?" in advance.
 - Every participant will prepare a brief proposal. If it is difficult to find a proposal which is directly related to world peace, it will be also allowed to propose an approach from a daily basis which eventually contributes to world peace.
 - The plan should be concrete.
 - It could be any kind (field) of plan which will create (help) world peace.
 - It could be a local plan and also a global plan.
 - Consider as a citizen of the earth, and bring your plan not only for your country but for all on this planet.
- 3. Each group (3 groups) prepares their own plan according to the theme.
 - Group will be mixed with <u>different country members</u>. All participants will be selected among <u>3 groups</u>.
 - Exchange information of current society system to keep peace in each country.
 - Discuss together, and finally select one plan as a group plan.
 - The plan should be concrete and clear.
 - Prepare presentation of the group plan together.
 - Presentation should be within 3 minutes on each side.
 - Use photos and diagrams to explain it clearly. (A4 or A3 panels)
- 4. <u>Presenter(s)</u> of your school & region's introduction:
 - Select student(s) as presenter(s).
- 5. Presenter(s) of group plan:
 - Select <u>student(s)</u> as presenter(s).
- 6. <u>Translators</u> should understand the flow of translation, because everyone is gathering on

the same screen at the same time. They need to translate sequentially.

Conference Rules

- 1. All participating students are expected to ask questions or express opinions.
- 2. <u>Do not criticize other group's ideas or opinions</u> by own standards. Constructive questions or opinions are welcome.

 - → Translator 2 (native language 2) → Speaker

Role list at the conference

- Conference manager: hosts and controls and facilitates the entire activity.
- Conference staff: support the conference and the conference manager.
- Observer (teacher): Each country has one manager who takes care of their participants.
